The amending Directions come into operation on 1 April 1977, except that, where necessary, they will come into operation before that date for the purpose of any procedures relating to an election held on or after 1 April 1977 (eg the district council elections due on 3 May 1977).

In consequence of the provisions of the Highland and Strathclyde Regions (Duror and Glen Etive and Glencoe) Boundaries Order 1977 (S.I.1977/22) I hereby direct as follows in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sub-paragraphs (1) and (3) of paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973:-

1. For the purpose of elections to which paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 applies, the constituent districts of the Highland Region specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to the Direction dated 15 November 1973 shall be divided into wards designated as specified opposite thereto in column 2 of the said Schedule and each such ward shall have the contents specified opposite its designation in column 3 of the said Schedule, subject to the amendments thereto specified in the Schedule to this Direction; and Schedule 2 (contents of electoral divisions in the said region) to the Direction dated 15 November 1973 shall be construed accordingly.
2. (1) Subject to the provision of sub-paragraph (2) hereof, this Direction shall come into operation on 1 April 1977.
(2) For the purpose of a notice of election or other procedure relating to an election to be held on or after 1 April 1977, this Direction shall come into operation as at the date hereof.

In consequence of the provisions of the Highland and Strathclyde Regions (Duror and Glen Etive and Glencoe) Boundaries Order 1977 (S.I.1977/22) I hereby direct as follows in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sub-paragraphs (1) and (3) of paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973:-

1. For the purpose of elections to which paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 applies, the constituent districts of the Strathclyde Region specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to the Direction dated 22 November 1973 shall be divided into wards designated as specified opposite thereto in column 2 of the said Schedule and each such ward shall have the contents specified opposite its designation in column 3 of the said Schedule, subject to the amendments thereto specified in the Schedule to this Direction; and Schedule 2 (contents of the electoral divisions in the said region) to the Direction dated 22 November 1973 shall be construed accordingly.
2. (1) Subject to the provision of sub-paragraph (2) hereof, this Direction shall come into operation on 1 April 1977.

(2) For the purpose of a notice of election or other procedure relating to an election to be held on or after 1 April 1977, this Direction shall come into operation as at the date hereof.
