To whom it may concern,

I fully support the boundary change to move the Dunlop Estate in Stepps into North Lanarkshire, as it seems ridiculous that this housing development - which is only accessible via passing through a substantial distance of North Lanarkshire - is serviced by Glasgow City Council.

I was surprised to learn of this situation and annoyed that Glasgow City Council have allowed this to happen. How can Glasgow City Council view this situation as viable and economic, servicing an area which is remote from the city? Gritters and refuse collections need to exit Glasgow City Council boundaries and cross into and through North Lanarkshire boundaries to enter one collection of streets - this seems ridiculous and a waste of resources seeing as the North Lanarkshire vehicles etc are already operating within the area and will be able to service this estate faster than any vehicle coming all the way from Glasgow.

The only sensible and economic resolution is for the boundary to be realigned, which as a tax payer within Glasgow City Council, I would expect Glasgow Council to support.
