To whom it may concern,

I am writing on behalf of my husband and myself, regarding the consultation on the change of boundary from Glasgow City Council to North Lanarkshire.

I would like to confirm that we are in favour of this boundary change and it makes full sense for this to take place. It is ridiculous that we are the only small part of a much wider estate that sits within the Glasgow boundary and that we have very separate services as a result. Whilst we receive regular services from Glasgow City Council it does mean that twice as much traffic comes into the estate unnecessarily as a result.

We also feel that Glasgow Council are making wider decisions that impact us, on the basis of us being part of a specific Glasgow City Council boundary i.e Robroyston, Millerston and Easterhouse, but these are not communities that we are part of or wish to be part of. As the crow flies we may be close to these areas on a map, but in reality we are part of the North Lanarkshire community in everything all but name.

We do not have children and therefore are not impacted by this issue, I can understand how our neighbours are feeling as the schools Glasgow Council suggest in their letter as suitable really are not close or easily accessible on the school run. Yet again this is an example of Glasgow City Council lumping us in with other communities rather than our own.

We are in full support of this boundary change to North Lanarkshire at the earliest opportunity.
